Government Funded Accommodations

We are able to help local communities during this time of crisis by partnering with local representatives to provide hotel accommodations to public employees, relief organization members, as well as vulnerable populations.

Shelter-in-Peace Hotels

Our gratitude goes out to all first responders and essential employees, who in the face of danger continue to serve our communities every day. Protecting their families and loved ones is a top priority, and one that can be challenging with family members living under the same roof. We provide comfortable accommodations to these workers to help prevent transmission through self-isolation.

We have opened this option to advance reservations, as the demand for these units is high and there is limited availability.



Recovery Center Hotels

As the increase of COVID-19 patients threatens to overwhelm our healthcare system, we have stepped up to help support our local communities. We are able to convert entire hotels to alternate care sites, called Recovery Centers, as demand warrants. These Recovery Centers will work with medical facilities to serve patients who are no longer considered critical and are released from hospitals, but still need plenty of rest and support, or simply prefer not to recover near loved ones at home.

Enhanced hygiene measures to ensure your safety:



Our Shelter-in-Peace accommodations available at every hotel follow protocol to either leave rooms offline for five days between guest stays, or are heat treated with temperatures of at least 135 degrees for three hours prior to check in, which is the recommended disinfecting protocol per World Health Organization.



Our Recovery Centers offer food delivery 24/7 following our ZMC food prep and delivery protocol, including chain of custody (date and time records with body temperature verification of all those involved in the food prep and delivery process).



Oxygen concentration devices are also provided for rent, based on availability, to help with higher quality breathing.
